### **BUILDING DESCRIPTION:**

A. Constructed in 1899, this two-story building structure is characterized by hand-crafted brick veneer design. The building faces north and has a metal awning that is appropriately designed to complete the era of the building.

The downstairs consists of 20 private professional office for attorneys. The downstairs also features a conference room, work area and elevated breakroom area. This area is heated and cooled and contains approximately 9,000 square feet.

The upstairs transforms time and is used for storage. Formerly a hotel with tall ceilings with the original metal ceilings and original fireplaces are found in the room.

The front of the building overlooks the courthouse and commands a fabulous view of the town square.
